Canada's International Climate Financing

In November 2015, Canada announced a climate finance investment of CAD \$2.65 billion over 5 years to help countries tackle the challenges of climate change and support their transition to low-carbon economies under the Paris Agreement.

Strong focus on:

- Adaptation and support for the poorest and most vulnerable populations impacted by climate change;
- Support for NDC Implementation;
- Support for the institutions and financial mechanisms of the UNFCCC;
- Mobilization of private sector investments.



Support for NDC implementation in Chile

Objective:

Support policy development and technology deployment with the aim to reduce emissions from the waste management sector.

Budget:

\$7M over 4 years

Priorities

1. Reduction of methane emissions through policy development and technology deployment in selected cities.
2. Tracking, monitoring and reporting emission reductions as well as explore opportunities for new and innovative cooperative arrangements.
3. Leverage co-financing from public and private sector partners to create financial enabling conditions for scaled-up implementation
4. Provide technical support for communications opportunities



Expected outcomes

- Through this approach, Canada is continuing to support the development of government-driven mitigation strategies that will ultimately:
 - Support the development of policies and the deployment of technologies to significantly reduce Short Lived Climate Pollutants (SLCPs)
 - Support the implementation of Nationally Determined Contributions (NDC).
 - Deliver direct environmental and health co-benefits.
 - Leverage significant public and private investments
 - Support other countries by helping Chile share experiences and practices to scale up implementation globally through south-south cooperation.

Annex: Pacific Alliance

Objective:

- Coordination and technical support to the Technical Sub-Group on Measurement, Reporting and Verification (MRV) and Climate Change (SGT-MRV) of the Pacific Alliance.
- Aim is to strengthen greenhouse gas (GHG) and short-lived climate pollutant (SLCPs) emissions MRV mechanisms to help the four countries achieve their respective NDCs in support of the Paris Agreement.

Budget:

- \$1.6M over 4 years

Complemented by:

- \$3.5M to enhance MRV in West Africa and support South-South cooperation within and between countries in the Pacific Alliance and West Africa
